The Usage of "Nihongo Room"

[What is "Nihongo Room"?]

- "Nihongo Room" is a place where people learning Japanese and local residents can connect.
- Local residents volunteer for free. They are not professionals.
- Volunteers and learners are paired one-on-one. However, if learners have the same level, it may be one volunteer for two or three learners.
- "Nihongo Room" is available once a week, 90 minutes each time.

[Cost]

- It is free (¥0).
- Textbooks can be borrowed from Kanagawa Ward International Lounge.
- Borrowed textbooks cannot be taken home.
- If you want to buy textbooks, they cost around \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{1,100}\) to \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{3,300}\) each. Please purchase from a book store.

[Contact Method]

- If you are absent, please notify us by the day before.
- If you are absent without notice twice in a row, you will lose your place.
- Use the LINE Open Chat for notification of absences.
- When the lounge is closed due to weather conditions such as typhoons or disasters, we will notify you via our website, Facebook and Instagram.

[Learning Rules]

- Try to ask questions in the class whenever possible.
- If you are absent for 5 classes in a row, you will not be able to keep your classes.
- If a volunteer is absent, you are welcomed to come to the class and practice Japanese conversation with the staff.
- To experience various types of Japanese, volunteers may change.
- Activities outside of "Nihongo Room" are not volunteer work.
 However, if both learners and volunteers agree, they will not be restricted.
- If you have any problems, please consult the lounge reception.
- The class period is one year. After that, you can reapply for classes again.
